Location & Directions

Located less than a mile from the intersection of I-684 and the Hutchinson River Parkway The Centre at Purchase is an easy commute from Manhattan, Greenwich, Stamford, Rye, Harrison and numerous other cities located on or near any of the major interstates which traverse Westchester County. All major regional highways and primary roads traverse through Westchester, and the four most heavily traveled roadways converge within a five minute drive of the Property: I-684, I-95, the Hutchinson River Parkway (Merritt Parkway), and the Cross Westchester Expressway. Westchester is only 25-miles north of midtown Manhattan and is a 40-minute train ride from Grand Central Station on Metro North.
